

Project submission guidelines

- When required, test files for your program are available at arthur.cs.vt.edu . Anonymous ftp to the server and use your email id as a password. The files are in the directory “pub/CS3204”.

- You will create a TAR’ed and GZIPped file named as outlined below:

<last name><first initial><middle initial>##.tar.gz
where ## is the submission number.

For example: arthurjd01.tar.gz

- The most recent submission (i.e. the submission with the highest number) will be the one chosen for grading.

- Your “tar.gz” submission should contain:

- Source code**
- Binary (compiled using the “-static” option)
Use the command “file FN” to be sure you included the -static option was used when you compiled your program
- Input files *that I provide*** and your corresponding outputs**
- A README file** containing:
 - Name
 - Social Security Number
 - How to invoke the program
 - What works and what does not
 - A synopsis of any “extra credit” work
- Makefile or “make script”
- Any additional input/output files** showcasing your extra credit work

- *Hard copies of all items starred (**) above must also be handed in during class on the due date.*

- Your tarfile MUST NOT contain any directories

- Upload your file via ftp to arthur.cs.vt.edu. CD to the pub/incoming/CS3204 directory. “Put” your tar.gz file there.
