

Research Project Description and Rules

In this project, your team will research in depth an Internet technology or issue that was not covered in class and present your findings in class. This project has two main parts:

Proposal

Due: March 19.

Format: A 1/2 page write-up per team.

How to submit: Submit the PDF file of your proposal (one per team) to the Curator (<http://courses.cs.vt.edu/curator/CourseLinks.html>).

Description:

Describe briefly which technology or issue your team is going to research.

Important: If you do *not* hear back from the GTA by March 21, your proposal is fine. We will only contact you, if your proposal is unacceptable and has to be modified.

Presentation

Date: The presentations will be scheduled based on their respective topics, with the related topics scheduled on the same date. On March 24, all the presentation dates will be posted on the class's schedule Web page.

Format: 25 minutes per team.

Description:

1.) You group will present your findings. You can either nominate a single speaker representing your group or have more than one speaker. You can use PowerPoint slides, example programs, or any other presentation devices that can help you get your point across. Please e-mail all your presentation materials to the instructor on the day of your presentation.

2.) Prepare class notes (2-4 pages max), make copies, and hand them out in class before your presentation.
